### PAVILION RESERVATION & DEPOSIT:

Payment is due within 5 days of reserving pavilion.

You have the option to allow us to keep a car count and at the end of the event you can pay \$1 per car for your guests or we can charge them directly \$2 at entrance

### PAVILION CANCELLATION & CREDITS:

A Cancellation of less than 48 hours from the reservation date for the pavilions will result in forfeiture.

No credit will be issued due to the eviction of the occupant.

*Day Pass (per vehicle) \$ 4.00*

## CAMPSITE REGISTRATION PROCEDURES:

- Visitors are to register at the office and pay the appropriate fees upon arrival. Each campsite will be given 2 vehicle tags, which will have the number of your site and the dates of your rental agreement. It should be placed so it is visible from the road.
- If visitors arrive after 5:00 p.m., they will need to register at the office before 10:00 a.m. the following day.
- Each Campsite is allowed 2 vehicles. Generally, this is the camping vehicle and 1 other. No additional vehicles will be allowed overnight. Guests visiting your site will need to check in with the office and get a daily vehicle tag.
- All rentals must be made by persons of at least 18 years of age, have a Valid Driver's License present, and be present during the site's occupation.
- Check out is 3:00p.m.

## RESERVATION RULES AND PROCEDURES

- Camper can reserve only 2 sites at any given time
- Reservation must be paid no later than 5 days from the date it was made (camp site and pavilion)
- NO discounts (senior) will be given for holidays (Labor Day, Independence Day, Memorial Day, etc.) or special events (Halloween, etc.)

- Camper cannot reserve the same site for consecutive visits
- Holidays and Halloween reservations require a 7 night minimum stay. NO refunds/rain checks will be given without a 5-day notice. Less than a 5-day notice will require forfeiture of 2 night's fees. No refunds/rainchecks if camper leaves in less than 7 days. •  
Reservations can only be made 6 months in advance

## PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Park facilities and grounds must be kept clean and left neat.
- A camper can stay a maximum of 14 days. After 14 days, campers must exit the park for 48 hours before returning.
- Quiet hours are from 10:00 p.m. - 6:00 a.m.
- No loud or obscene music is permitted at any time.
- No abusive, boisterous, offensive, threatening language or behavior will be tolerated.
- No alcoholic beverages are allowed in the park.
- Pets must be on a leash, must not be left unattended, and cannot be tied to trees.
- Camping is only allowed in designated areas.
- Extinguish campfires after use. Campfires CANNOT be left unattended.
- Do not use any wood with nails to construct a campfire. Wooden pallets are not allowed in the park and cannot be burned in a campfire.
- Do not cut trees or vegetation in the Park.
- No hunting is allowed in the Park. No fireworks or firearms are permitted in the Park.
- Vehicles shall be parked in designated areas only.
- A valid driver's license is required to operate a golf cart.
- No more passengers can ride on a golf cart than the amount of seats on the cart.
- Only battery-operated vehicles are allowed in the park. ATV/UTV's are not permitted.
- Except for handicapped vehicles, no motorized vehicles are allowed on trails.
- No appliances are allowed outside of campers or RV's.

- No person under 12 years of age is allowed in the park unless accompanied by an adult,
- Campers will be held responsible their visitors' compliance with these rules.
- Violation of any park rule may result in eviction without refund. By signing these rules, you indicate that you have read them and fully understand that any violations may, at the Park Director's sole discretion, be grounds for immediate removal from the park and could, at the Park Director's sole discretion, result in either temporary or permanent eviction.

## PARK RULES

- Park facilities and grounds must be kept clean and left neat.
- A Camper can stay a maximum of 14 days, then will have to exit the Park for 48 hours before returning.
- Quiet hours are from 10:00p.m. - 6:00a.m.
- No loud music at any time.
- No abusive, boisterous, offensive, or threatening language or behavior.
- No alcoholic beverages are allowed in the Park.
- Pets must be on a leash and must not be left unattended. Not tied to trees. Must be kept inside camper.
- Camp only in designated areas.
- Do not leave campfires unattended.
- Extinguish campfires after use.
- No cutting of trees or vegetation allowed in the Park.
- No hunting, firearms, or fireworks are allowed in the Park.
- Vehicles shall be parked in designated areas only.
- You need a valid Driver's License to operate a Golf Cart.
- No more passengers than the amount of seats on golf carts.
- No ATVs.
- Except for handicapped vehicles, no motorized vehicles are allowed on trails.
- No appliances are allowed outside of campers or RVs.
- No person under 12 years of age is allowed in the Park unless accompanied by an adult.
- Violation of any Park rule is grounds for eviction.

## INFORMATION

### CAMPSITE REGISTRATION PROCEDURES:

### CANCELLATION & CREDITS:

- A Cancellation less than 5 days from the reservation date will result in forfeiture of payment for 2 days stay. Rain checks will be issued for the remainder.
- No credit will be issued due to the eviction of the occupant.

### GENERAL CAMPSITE INFORMATION:

- All rentals must be made by persons of at least 18 years of age, have a valid Driver's License present, and be present during the site's occupation.
- Check out is 3:00 p.m.



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
